Summary of work completed since last report which supports the delivery of the commission

This project aims to build a cohesive central picture of all data in processes and systems that directly and indirectly impact children and their families in Scotland. Uniquely, this project approaches the mapping exercise from the perspective of 'what matters' to children and families, as opposed to being driven by the organisations and systems that currently exist.

South Ayrshire Council and Health and Social Care Partnership are the only organisations taking part in this project. The Project Team have met with lead officers of services across the organisations to ask key questions regarding the data they collect including:

- Who is included in the data?
- Is there an identifier for care experience?
- Is the information collected solely by your department or is there data from other departments?
- What fields are data routinely collected for?
- Is the data checked or validated before use?
- Can the data be linked to other datasets through common identifiers like CHI number?
- Is the data shared?
- How often is it collected?
- Is there software used to store the data?
- Do you have surveys on user experience?

The project has recently produced a draft report on the investigation into how to collect and map data on 'what matters' to children and families using the information provided by South Ayrshire and other stakeholders such as Skills Development Scotland, SCRA, Police Scotland, Strathclyde University, Ayrshire college and Public Health Scotland.

Key observations in the report include:

- Learning from the stakeholder engagement i.e., ensuring stakeholders are given information on the purpose of the exercise and what is being asked of

them.

- Linking to what matters i.e., consider the difficulty of mapping what is collected to what matters.

Once the report is finalised, this will be shared with the Corporate Parenting Executive Group.
