

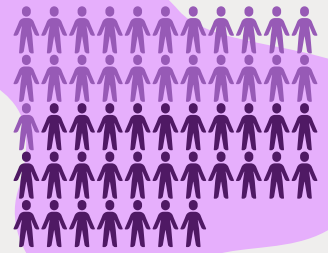
Post School Destinations Looked after leavers 2020/21

Stirling's 2020/21 post-school destination data for looked after children relates to young people educated within Stirling and recorded as being on statutory measures at the point of the September 2020 education census.

Staying on

51 S4-6 learners were recorded as looked after in Stirling schools in the Sept 2020 census.

- 23 left school that year
- 12 from S4, 9 left during or at the end of S5, and 2 at the end of S6

Initial leaver destination

22 of 23 leavers (95.7%) positive dest.

- Highest recorded figure to date by over 5%
- Above the National average for LAC and overall
- 7.8% above the national average
- 10 (44%) Further Education
- 2 (9%) Higher Education

Providing ongoing support

What is working?

- Strengthened monitoring and tracking in schools
- Trauma informed practice in schools and partner organisations
- Dedicated resource from VHT
- Increased partnership working
- Flexible curriculum approaches in senior phase
- Refreshed transition guidance in education
- Person centred approaches to transition planning

Key issues with data

- Very small data set
- Figures depend on the cohort each year



Next steps

- Strengthen focus on **sustained** destinations across system
- Participatory budgeting
- eLearning module for ALL education
- Embed person centred approaches across children's services
- Flexible pathways development
