
Scottish Child Interview Model for Joint Investigative Interviewing Emerging Learning – Lanarkshire Social Work

This learning from Lanarkshire Joint Investigative Interviewing Project sets out the Plan Do Study Act cycles that were used to test the deployment and management of social workers within their new roles. It includes use of a rota system to deploy interviewers, location of the team, workload, and management options.

Lanarkshire Joint Investigative Interviewing Project –Learning from social work interviewer deployment and management



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No rota – 6 social workers all available for JII as main priority. 4 team leaders - one local authority identifies one team leader for their staff; the other local authority retains the 3 original team leaders. **Central base** –social workers co-located with police colleagues. **Minimal locality workload** – case loads significantly reduced to create capacity for JII

No rota – 6 social workers all available for JII as main priority. 6 team leaders - each social worker managed by original team leaders. Central base -social workers primarily based with police colleagues in central location. **Reducing locality workload** – case loads reduced to create capacity for JII.

No rota – 6 social workers all available for JII as main priority. 6 team leaders - each social worker managed by original team leaders. 6 locality teams – each social worker based in original locality team. Locality workload – case load retained by each social worker

Weekly rota – 6 social workers booked onto a weekly JII rota. 6 team leaders - each social worker managed by original team leaders. 6 locality teams – each social worker based in original locality team. Locality workload – case load retained by each social worker

Daily rota – 6 social work interviewers booked onto a daily JII rota. **6 team leaders** – each social worker managed by original team leaders. 6 locality teams – each social worker based in original locality team. Locality workload – case load retained by each social worker
