Private Session

1. Introduction

The President welcomed those present and provided guidance on how the Special Leaders' meeting would be conducted remotely using Microsoft Teams. Apologies and substitutes had been noted separately for the Minute.

The President thanked Leaders' for joining at short notice and advised that a 30 minute recess would be held following the presentation of the two main items to allow for further debate on the amendments submitted.

2. Additional Business Support and Welfare Funding (paper)

Leaders' attention was drawn to the announcement by the First Minister, Nicola Sturgeon, on 17 November 2020 about a range of additional business support, to be delivered via local authorities. In addition, she announced funding of £15m for welfare and social support for Level 4 councils only. The paper presented the proposition as developed by Scottish Government.

Two amendments to the recommendations were proposed.

Amendment One

Proposed by Councillor Jonathan McColl Seconded by Councillor Cecil Meiklejohn

Replace recommendations with:

Leaders agree that Local Government administers the grants outlined in the paper.

COSLA welcomes the additional support for businesses from the Scottish Government, over and above existing financial support, such as furlough top up and strategic framework grants. We also welcome that £30m of this is discretionary funding for Local Government to use to support businesses to suit local needs.

We recognise that this is an extremely difficult time for all businesses in all of our communities and as some areas move into Level 4 today, it is a particular and immediate challenge for those businesses. We also acknowledge that any of our Council areas may be escalated to level 4 in the future.

In recognition of this current context, COSLA calls on the Scottish Government to continue to support businesses by agreeing additional discretionary funding for all businesses in all levels. COSLA also agrees that at this juncture officers develop appropriate distribution options for the currently available £30m, for consideration by the SDG, based on the following principles;

Number and size of businesses affected & requiring support will vary by area.

Impact on business will be greater in Level 4 areas and immediate priority needs to be given to those areas.

Method of distribution requires to take account of the differential impact but ensuring that all councils benefit in some way.

Distribution should be calculated in relation to the business base, rather than by population or GAE.

Leaders agree that proposed recommendations on distribution from SDG will be considered at the Leaders meeting next week.

Amendment Two

Proposed by Councillor Norman Hampshire Seconded by Councillor Stephen McCabe

Leaders note that at the meeting held on 30 October 2020 Leaders agreed to:

- (b) express their concerns that many businesses and individuals would be adversely affected by the restrictions introduced under the new strategic framework of tiers without adequate financial support that would help keep people in employment and businesses viable; and
- (c) agree to request that the Scottish Government, as a matter of urgency, reviews the financial support framework in the context of the new strategic framework of tiers and engages with Local Government, to ensure as many businesses and individuals as possible are adequately supported.

Leaders welcome the additional Business Support and Welfare Funding announced by the Scottish Government this week but believe that this is inadequate to meet the needs of businesses and families in communities across Scotland. Leaders agree:

- 1. that Local Government should administer these support package schemes as outlined in this report;
- 2. that the joint Scottish/Local Government project group will prepare to implement the business grant schemes without delay, including agreeing the high level guidance for the discretionary scheme;
- that officers will also seek views from the Settlement and Distribution Group in relation to distribution of all 4 funds, with a view to agreeing this formally at Leaders on 27th November, noting that the £30m Local Authority Discretionary Support for Business should be distributed across all 32 local authorities; and
- 4. that Cosla should seek substantial additional funding from Scottish Government to more adequately meet the needs of businesses and families affected by the strategic framework of tiers across Scotland, in particular for those areas in Tier 4.

3. Local Government Support for COVID-19 Vaccinations (paper)

Leaders welcomed the recent positive news from the various vaccine trials taking place around the world. Details continued to emerge around the requirements to vaccinate the population safely and the paper outlined early thinking on priority groups. The specific asks of Local Government would become clear as more certainty about the vaccines became available. COSLA officers provided clarification on several points and reported on representations already made to Scottish Government around Local Government involvement and specific local arrangements to be considered when implementing the delivery of a vaccination programme e.g. rural and island communities, logistics and transport requirements. Leaders emphasised the need to ensure information was issued as soon as possible.

Amendment

An amendment to the recommendations was proposed by Cllr Susan Aitken and seconded by Cllr Scott Farmer

Delete recommendation (iii) and replace with:

Agree that Local Government will support the delivery of the vaccination programme and will work with the Scottish & UK Governments, Community Planning Partners and others to identify and secure the necessary resources to support this.

Cllr Shona Haslam, seconded by Cllr Andrew Polson then moved the recommendations in the report.

- (ii) noted the letter from the Cabinet Secretary seeking Local Government support; and
- (iii) agreed, that Local Government would support the delivery of the vaccination programme and would work with the Scottish and UK Governments, Community Planning Partners and others to identify and secure the necessary resources to support this.
